



**GOVERNOR APARTMENTS AFFORDABLE HOUSING  
OPPORTUNITY  
REOPENING WAITING LIST**

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Governor Apartments will be accepting applications for **Studio, 1, and 2** bedroom family housing units under the Section 8 Program. Eligible applicants will be placed on an existing waiting list by random order via a lottery, **not by the order in which the completed application is received.**

Applications will be accepted from **Wednesday, March 1, 2023, through Friday, March 31, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.** (the “lottery period”) either in person, via e-mail or via USPS mail. Applications must be received or postmarked with a date of March 1<sup>st</sup> through March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023. Applications after this date will not be accepted for the lottery.

The lottery selection will be held on **Tuesday, April 11, 2023, at Noon**; you do not need to be in attendance for the selection process since you will be notified of your position on the waiting list. Interested applicants may obtain an application by:

Completed applications should be submitted to Governor Apartments at 209 Kelton Street Allston, MA, 02134, in person, by mail by Friday, March 31, 2023, at 5:00 p.m. or by e-mail to [Governorapplications@wingatecompanies.com](mailto:Governorapplications@wingatecompanies.com). All applicants must be determined eligible in accordance with the Department of HUD regulations and must meet household size requirements for a designated bedroom size as well as maximum income of all household members. The waiting list will remain open after the lottery period and applications will be processed in order of receipt from that point forward.
